- COMPETITIONS -

SECTION A: CHURCH CHOIRS' COMPETITION (PARTS)

- TWO contrasting pieces of own choice only ONE of which may be accompanied
- Both pieces performed have to fall within the category of sacred music
- Open to Church Choirs ONLY unlimited voices

SECTION B: CHURCH CHOIRS' COMPETITION (UNISON)

- ONE set piece ('Praise my soul') & ONE piece (sacred music) of own choice
- Open to Church Choirs ONLY unlimited voices UNISON

SECTION C: GREGORIAN CHANT COMPETITION

- ONE set piece ('Attende Domine') & ONE piece of own choice from either the *Liber Usualis* or the *Graduale Romanum*
- · Open to all choirs unlimited voices

SECTION D: SACRED MUSIC COMPETITION

- TWO contrasting pieces of own choice only ONE of which may be accompanied
- Both pieces performed must fall within the category of sacred music.
- Open to youth, gospel & adult choirs any combination of voice

SECTION E: EARLY MUSIC COMPETITION

- TWO pieces of own choice, which pre-date 1620 any combination of voice
- One piece performed must fall within the category of sacred music.
- Open to all choirs unlimited voices

SECTION F: PRIMARY SCHOOL CHOIRS' COMPETITION (Under 13 years)

- TWO contrasting pieces of own choice
- One piece performed must fall within the category of sacred music.
- Unison or parts, male or female or mixed

SECTION G: POST-PRIMARY SCHOOLS' COMPETITION (Equal Voice)

- TWO contrasting pieces of own choice
- One piece performed must fall within the category of sacred music.
- SSA(A) or TTB(B). Three parts minimum would general be entered in this competition.

SECTION H: POST-PRIMARY SCHOOLS' COMPETITION (Mixed Voice)

- TWO contrasting pieces of own choice any combination of voice
- One piece performed must fall within the category of sacred music.
- Mixed Voices SAB; SABar; or SATB. The composition of the upper parts can either be female SA, or male SA unbroken voices.

SECTION I: YOUTH CHOIRS' COMPETITION

- TWO contrasting pieces in any number of parts only ONE of which may be accompanied
- One piece performed has to fall within the category of sacred music.
- Open to any combination of voices (16-24 years).

SECTION J: GOSPEL CHOIRS' COMPETITION

- Two contrasting pieces of own choice only ONE of which may be accompanied
- One piece performed must fall within the category of sacred music.
- Open to all choirs unlimited voices

SECTION K: COMMUNITY CHOIRS' COMPETITION

- Two contrasting pieces of own choice only ONE of which may be accompanied
- One piece performed must fall within the category of sacred music.
- Open to all non-professional choirs unlimited voices.

SECTION L: JUNIOR YOUTH CHOIRS' COMPETITION

- TWO contrasting pieces of own choice
- One piece performed must fall within the category of sacred music.
- Open to any combination of voices: upper age limit is 15 years.
- Note: Section not open to individual schools

- RULES & REGULATIONS -



- The closing date for applications to the 2025 Festival is Monday, 3rd February 2025.
- Appropriate fee(s) must accompany all entries and is **non-refundable**.
- A separate entry form is required for each competition; please photocopy application form where necessary
- **ONE** piece performed must fall within the category of **sacred music.**
 - o In the case of the following <u>four</u> competitions, **BOTH** pieces performed must fall within the category of **sacred music** (Sacred Music Competition, Church Choirs' Competition (PARTS), Church Choirs' Competition (UNISON), Gregorian Chant Competition).
- Total performance for any choir must not exceed eight (8) minutes. Failure to comply with this may result in disqualification
- Use of backing tracks is prohibited in all categories.
- School choirs are NOT eligible to compete in Section I (Youth Choirs' Competition).
- One clear copy of each piece chosen must accompany the entry form. In each case, label the scores with the choir's name. Original scores are returned to the choirs by either:
 - o collection at the end of the competition after results
 - by post: in this case, you must include a large stamped addressed envelope with your entry form allowing sufficient postage for the package weight
- Change of submitted programme is not permitted.
- The same piece may not be performed by a choir in more than one competition.
- Competitors are encouraged to provide their own accompaniment.
 - However, if you require an accompanist (at your expense), please forward a second copy of the music and we will discuss what arrangements can be made. In such cases, please state this clearly on the application form.
- All perpetual trophies must be returned to the committee on or before 21st February 2025.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel a competition should there not be sufficient entries
- The decision of the adjudicators is final.
- Limerick Choral Festival Society reserves the right to record, interview, and photograph choirs during the Festival.
- Note: The Limerick Choral Festival Society is committed to best practice in the welfare and safeguarding of minors.
